

CRITERIA FOR ALLOTMENT PLOT JUDGING

1) CULTIVATION.

- a) Defined edges to plot and tidy pathways.....5 points.
b) Cleanliness-i.e. Lack of weeds throughout plot, including vacant land.....15 points.
c) Labelling of plot. i.e. Plot number clearly displayed.....5 points.

TOTAL 25 POINTS.

2) CROPPING

- a) Variety of crops-2 pts for each type of vegetable, flower or fruit to a maximum of.....30 points
b) Continuity –signs of successive sowing, planting or rotation, inc. winter crops.....5 points
c) Utilisation of space, maximising available space.....5 points
d) Labelling of crops.....5 points

TOTAL 45 POINTS.

3) QUALITY

A maximum of 20 points to be awarded in this section

- High level quality, good colour, vigour, little or no weather damage etc.13-20 points
Medium level, less vigorous some damage dead leaves etc.....6-12 points
High levels of damage poorly grown weakly plants etc.....0-5 points

TOTAL 20 POINTS.

4) PESTS AND DISEASES

A maximum of 20 points to be awarded in this section

- Low incidence of pests and diseases.....13-20 points
Medium level.....6-12 points
High level.....0-5 points

MAXIMUM 20 POINTS

5) MISCELLANEOUS

- a) Compost heaps/boxes; evidence of active use, /recycling, use of recycled materials instead of new creative use of recycled materialsup to 10 points
b) Any additional noteworthy features, e.g.: overall appearance; wildlife features; bird boxes pond, etc;
food plants for insects.....up to 10 points.

TOTAL 20 POINTS

THEREFORE THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF POINTS OBTAINABLE BY ANY PLOT IS 130
